TERM

The 2023 Delegate Assembly will take place August 26 & 27, 2023 in Lincoln. Delegates officially serve a two-year term until the next Delegate Assembly, however, this is the only scheduled meeting during the term.

ABOUT THE DELEGATE ASSEMBLY

The Biennial NAPE Delegate Assembly is the highest decision making body of our union. Delegates are responsible for adopting amendments to our bylaws, strategic plan, and legislative platform. Delegates are also responsible for adopting resolutions and position statements, and they are responsible for electing the five officers of the union.

The 2023 Delegate Assembly will take place in Lincoln August 26 & 27, 2023, with a welcome reception on the evening of August 25. Delegates traveling more than 60 miles will be provided with a hotel room and reimbursed mileage for their trip to Lincoln.
